"Tricks and Treats — A Halloween Spectacular!" will include works by great composers, including some serious, scary and silly music. Concert-goers are invited to wear Halloween costumes.

"The concert has a wonderful grouping of short pieces that will beguile and enchant young listeners as well as grownups," said Wyner. "There are some all-time favorites by Bach and Ravel and Saint-Saëns, as well as Leroy

Anderson. The music has all kinds of tricks and disguises in it."

An instrumental petting zoo will be part of the event, in which youngsters can see the musicians up close. Art by area school children who entered the Music in Art contest will be projected onto a huge screen, and the winners will receive prizes. There also will be a costume parade, with refreshments and treats.

The program includes:

Bach's The Toccata and Fugue in d minor; Saint-Saëns' "Danse Macabre"; Rimsky-Korsakov's "Flight of the Bumblebee"; Ravel's "The Sleeping Beauty" and "Empress of the Pagodas" from the Mother Goose suite; Gounod's "Funeral March of the Puppets"; Smetana's "Dance of the Comedians" and Leroy Anderson's "The Waltzing Cat" and "The Syncopated Clock."
